Job Description MINISTER OF MUSIC St. Peter's Lutheran Church of Cape Cod

The Minister of Music position is a ministry of the mission of St. Peter's Lutheran Church. The Minister of Music performs as an organist, pianist, and choir and bell choir director. The Minister of Music position is a salaried church staff position that reports to the Pastor(s). The position involves planning and coordinating all aspects of music with the Pastor(s), the choirs and the Worship Team for an average of 20 hours/week.

The Minister of Music shall be responsible for the following:

- **A.** Preparation of music for Sunday worship and special services (see reverse)
 - 1. Hymns, Choral Anthems, organ and piano music (Prelude, Offering, Postlude) and liturgical music
 - 2. Sanctuary Choir, weekly
 - 3. Cantors when needed
 - 4. Handbell Choir, weekly
 - 5. Soloists and substitute organists
- **B.** Organize and direct all choirs, soloists and rehearsals
 - 1. Weekly rehearsals
 - 2. Sunday warm-ups before worship services
- **C.** Perform administrative responsibilities
 - 1. Collaborate with the Pastor(s) to plan worship services including liturgy and hymn selection
 - a. Sunday morning services
 - b. Special services
 - c. The format for each season of the church year
 - **2.** Provide the Ministry Administrator music information, including copyrights, for the bulletins
 - 3. Attend Worship Team meetings
 - 4. Attend weekly staff meetings as needed
 - 5. Prepare annual budget for the music ministry
 - a. Sheet music, instruments, music stands
 - b. Robes and supplies
 - c. Soloists and substitutes
 - d. Copyrights and podcast licenses
 - 6. Supervise organization and management of musical and choral resources
 - 7. Coordinate care and maintenance of organ, pianos and handbells
 - **8.** Have awareness of the audio portion of the audio-visual system including the mixer and its use for in person and livestream worship.
 - **D.** Coordinate and oversee musical outreach and publicity
 - 1. Participate in the plans for the new pipe organ arriving 2024
 - **2.** Encourage other musicians in the congregation to use their gifts for the glory of God in worship services.
 - **E.** Perform other responsibilities with additional compensation
 - 1. Coordinate musicians and music for funeral/memorial services
 - 2. Coordinate musicians and music for wedding services

Choirs participate at worship services Labor Day through early June (Pentecost or Holy Trinity).
