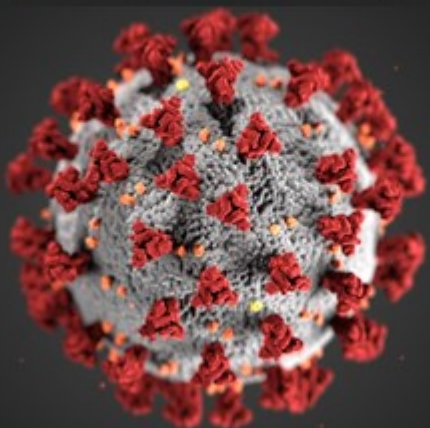


## St. Peter's Reopening Task Force Update



### Goals:

- \* Welcome people back, enjoy greater fellowship with fewer restrictions
- \* Have people feel safe
- \* Work towards a Lutheran "both and" with a hybrid model where possible (i.e. Church Council will meet in person but also zoom in anyone who feels safer joining virtually)

### May 30 and after:

For those fully vaccinated, masks are optional.

For those who are unvaccinated, masking and physical distancing are required.

### Indoor Worship:

**Pulpit side** for those "Fully vaccinated and comfortable in close proximity." Note, there will be no seating restrictions here, and no mask requirements.

**Organ side** for those "Not fully vaccinated or desiring physical distancing." Note, tape will remain to mark 6' distance and people on this side are expected to wear masks (Non-vaccinated are asked to mask for both their own safety and the safety of vaccinated but vulnerable populations).

Pre-registration is no longer required but we will ask you to sign in (for potential contact tracing).

### Singing:

We are choosing to take a Phased approach.

Phase 1: No singing inside. (While we wait to see what's happening in church and Harwich, make sure there are no major spikes) Singing OK at any outside service with masks on.

The Reopening Task Force will reassess singing protocols after 2 weeks.

### Meetings:

There will no longer be room capacity limits. No masking or distancing required for those who are fully vaccinated. Masking and distancing required for those not fully vaccinated. Open windows are encouraged for air flow. Continued sanitizing is encouraged as a courtesy to other groups using these rooms.
