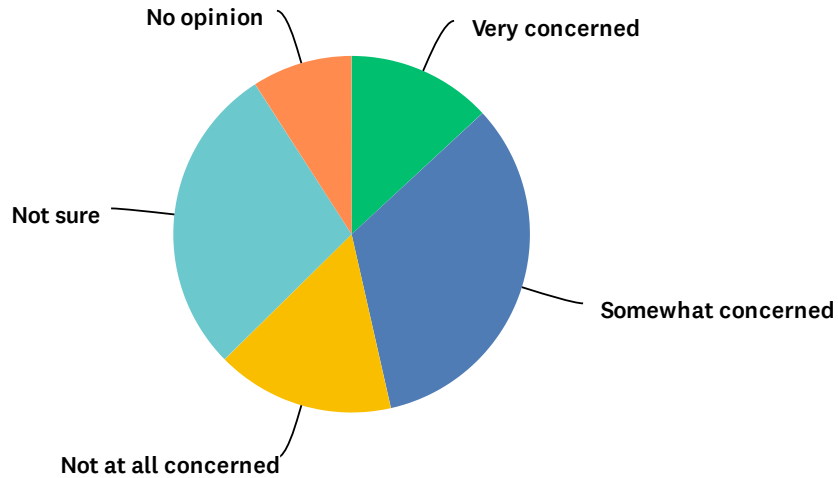

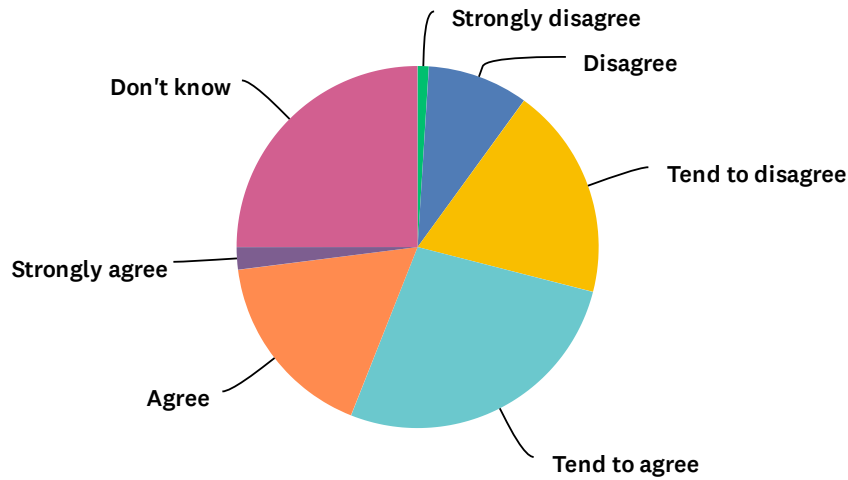

Q98 Most members of our church would be comfortable sharing faith-stories with persons in the communities where they live and work.

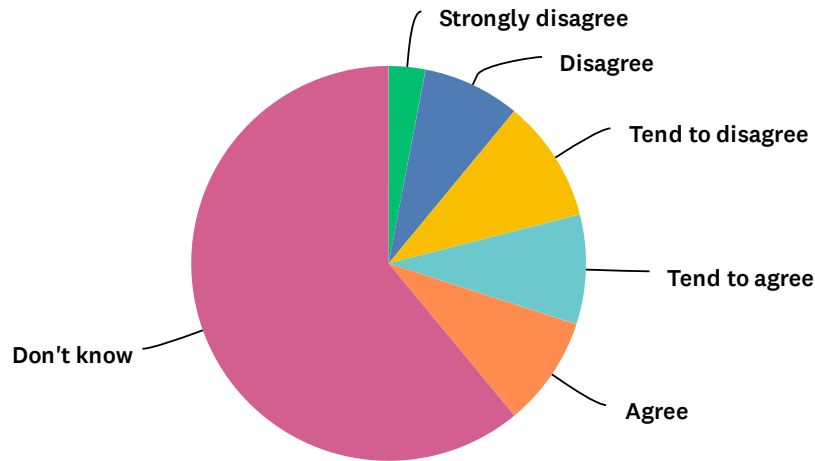
