The incoming administration in Washington has promised sweeping changes to current immigration policy, generating anxiety and fear among both undocumented newcomers and immigrants who enjoy legal status. St. Peter's has a history of support for newcomers, both through advocacy and more recently through the Safe Harbors Ministry. We will discuss questions about what to expect in the next months and years, explore the information offered by our national agencies, AMMPARO and Global Refuge, and discuss how we might respond if a threatened person should seek our help.
