Fun Fact #9 from your Pipes for Praise Team from our Music Director Craig Tocher: “Although I began playing the piano and organ in Sunday School and church at an early age (on a split keyboard Hammond electric!), my first encounter with a pipe organ and my first church job was at the age of 18 in Johannesburg. My earliest recollection of being smitten by the sound of a pipe organ was from an old 78 recording which my grandmother had of *The Lost Chord* by Arthur Sullivan (of Gilbert & Sullivan fame). I was inspired to study at Manhattan School of Music after hearing a recording of the magnificent strings on the Aeolian - Skinner organ at Riverside Church in NYC. Just as some people get a thrill from riding a motorcycle or driving a racing car, I feel the same way when you can take the organ from the softest of sounds to the loudest roar, which you can feel in your body and can rattle windows and shake the building.”
